Student Achievement

- SW Ohio students earned 5% of the Awards of Academic Achievement given nationally on the 2008 *HSTW* Assessment
- Students throughout Ohio earned 12.5% of those awards
- 66% of SW Ohio seniors met the college readiness reading goal in reading, 59% in math, and 61% in science, compared to the national average of 56%, 53%, and 51% respectively
- 58% of SW Ohio eighth-graders met high school readiness goals in reading, 58% in mathematics, and 54% in science, compared to the national average of 42%, 45%, and 37%, respectively
