### **Accreditation**

The Warren County Career Center Public Safety Services Program is “Chartered to Conduct Firefighter and EMS Training in Ohio – Accreditation No. 219” by the Ohio Department of Public Safety. State Fire Certification tests are given after each level.

## **FIRE SERVICE TRAINING**

### **Volunteer Firefighter 36 Hours**

The Volunteer Firefighter course is the basic entry course for persons joining volunteer or combination fire departments.

Students must meet Ohio Admission requirements. A medical statement of fitness is required for admission to this course. All personal protective equipment is required. (available for rent if needed)

### **Firefighter I Transition - 100 Hours with State of Ohio required EVO class**

The Firefighter I Transition course prepares the student to take the State Level 1 Firefighter certification test. You must meet Ohio admission requirements, be certified at Volunteer Firefighter Level, and submit a medical statement of fitness.

Books are the same as for the Volunteer FF class. All personal protective equipment is required. (available for rent if needed)

### **Firefighter II Transition - 120 Hours (Minimum)**

The Firefighter II Transition course prepares the Level 1 firefighter to take the State Firefighter Level 2 Certification test. Level 2 Certification is required to become a full time paid (career) fighter. To enroll in this course you must meet Ohio admission requirements, have Ohio Firefighter Level 1 Certification, and submit a medical statement of fitness.

Books are the same as for the Volunteer FF class. All personal protective equipment is required. (available for rent if needed)

### **Emergency Vehicle Operation (EVO) - 16 Hours**

EVO class topics include: rules, regulations and the law; emergency vehicle characteristics; vehicle maintenance; driver performance; vehicle placement; and backing and driving skills.

### **Fire Safety Inspector 80 Hours**

The Fire Safety Inspector course is the revised course as released by the Ohio Department of Public Safety. The course prepares students to take the Ohio Certification test for Fire Safety Inspector.

Prerequisites include: be an active member of a fire department; you must furnish your own current Ohio Building Code and Ohio Fire Code manuals.

### **Fire Inspector Refresher 10 Hours**

The Fire Inspector Refresher course is designed to meet the State of Ohio Annual Training/CEU requirements. Topics covered may include: Cause and Origin; Building and Fire Code updates; and alarms and suppression systems.

### **Fire/EMS Instructor 70 Hours**

The Fire/EMS Instructor course presents the information necessary for the instruction of adult students and basic teaching techniques. The course includes 50 hours of classroom instruction; 8 hours of instruction specific to either Fire or EMS, 10 hours of supervised teaching and 2 hours toward the completion of techniques exam.

Students must meet all ODPS requirements for entry to this course.

### **Rope Rescue – Operations Level Course 24 Hours**

The Rope Rescue course is for rescuers who need essential rope rescue skills to deal with hazards such as buildings, cliffs, towers, pits, wells, silos, etc.

The course is designed to provide instruction in the fundamentals of rope rescue with major emphasis on safety. You will learn personal and team skills through application of rope rescue systems, encompassing anchor systems, belay systems, rappelling and ascending, lowering systems, litter packaging and mechanical-advantage raising systems. You will analyze systems and solve problems in both low-angle and vertical environments.

The course covers the requirements of NFPA 1670 awareness and operations level skills.

#### **Special Requirements:**

Participants must have helmets, gloves, safety glasses or goggles and appropriate clothing for working outdoors.

### **Fire Refresher/ CEU's 18 Hours**

This course is designed to meet the State of Ohio annual training/CEU requirements. Topics covered will include: Fire Department Organization and Safety; Fire Behavior; Salvage and Overhaul; PPE/SCBA; Hose; Ladders; Ventilation; and ICS.

## EMT TRAINING

### **EMT First Responder 48 Hours**

The EMT First Responder course content meets the subject area content and objectives approved by the Ohio Department of Public Safety-Board of EMS. Competency is demonstrated through written and practical testing.

### **EMT – Basic 160 Hours**

The EMT-Basic course includes the academic and practical skills needed to prepare students to take the National Registry of EMT Certification test. A minimum of ten hours of clinical experience in a hospital and/or on a life squad is not included in hours.

- Recent TB test, Hepatitis B and MMR immunizations or titer

### **EMT Basic Refresher 32 Hours**

The EMT Basic Refresher course provides a review of EMT-Basic skills and knowledge. The course may be used as an Ohio recertification option, to extend attempts to pass the initial NREMT exam for certification, or to re-certify NREMT Basic certification.

You must have completed the EMT-Basic course to enroll.

### **EMT Intermediate 130 Hours (Clinical hours not included)**

The EMT Intermediate class prepares students with the practical and academic skills required to take the National Registry EMT-Intermediate certification test.

Prerequisites for this class include: a recent TB test, Hepatitis B and MMR immunizations or titer, current EMT-B certification and Work Keys assessment.

## **CPR TRAINING**

The Warren County Career Center is a CPR Training Center for the American Heart Association. Several types and levels of CPR training are available. Check with your employer or agency to determine which training you are required to maintain.

The American Heart Association requires every CPR student to have the proper textbook before, during and after the class. The American Heart Association strongly promotes knowledge and proficiency in BLS, ACLS and PALS and has developed instructional materials for this purpose. ### **Healthcare Provider CPR 5 Hours**

This course provides Initial CPR training for the medical professional or allied health worker. Training includes adult, child, infant CPR, AED and airway obstruction as well as bag valve mask. Practical and written tests are given. Completers receive a CPR card.
