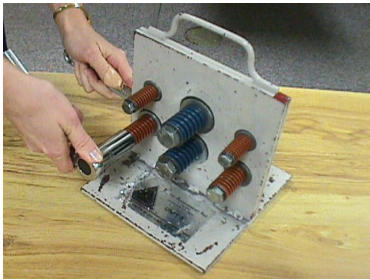

Consider Participating in a Career Assessment

Students visit the Career Assessment Lab for a day or two to investigate career interests, career-related skills, and consider future educational and career options.

Career skills assessed may include hands-on work samples to determine aptitude for tasks using the fingers, hands, and tools as well as clerical, reading, math, measuring, and handling money.



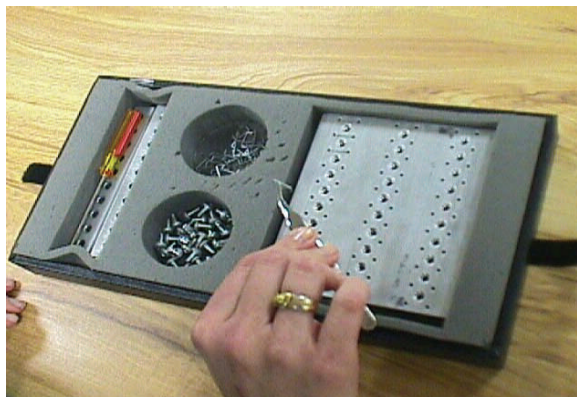
Upon completion of the career assessment, a follow-up meeting involving the student, parent, home-school personnel, and the Career Assessment Specialist is scheduled to review the results of the career assessment.

Who is Eligible?

Any student who is at least 14 years old who resides in the Warren County Career-Technical District.

Scheduling a Career Assessment

Teachers and counselors at the students' high school work closely with Career Center personnel to refer and schedule students for a Career Assessment. Parent/guardian permission is needed prior to the career assessment.



Where Does the Career Assessment Occur?

Students report to the Career Assessment Lab at the Warren County Career Center for their scheduled assessment. The home school is responsible for providing transportation to the Career Center.
