## WCCC Student Dress Code

The Warren County Career Center believes that appropriate dress and appearance is an important part of any effective career-technical program. Our school dress code reflects the expectations of business, industry, and the Warren County Career Center staff. **Please do not spend your hard-earned money on lots of shirts, shorts, capris, mini-skirts, extremely baggy or low-riding pants, etc.—as your child will not be able to wear them at WCCC. Our dress code is as follows and is strictly enforced:**

All students are required to wear WCCC program shirts and long pants or longer skirts (knee length or longer). **Shorts and capris are not permitted -- due to safety concerns.** Each career-technical instructor has selected program shirts/uniforms for their students to wear each day (some programs require additional items, as well). The shirts are purchased by the student and **MUST** be worn every day of school (unless otherwise noted). There will be **NO** exceptions to this dress code, or student will face disciplinary action.

The following guidelines are mandatory for all students and are to be adhered to consistently:

1. Students are expected to wear program/uniform shirts **EACH** school day.
2. Students are personally liable for all program/uniform shirts.
3. Students will regularly launder and maintain the appearance of the program/uniform shirts at all times.
4. Students will wear their program shirts/attire on all field trips or other appropriate attire, unless a school administrator gives prior approval to the instructor.
5. There are to be **NO HATS** worn in the building, except in lab settings.
6. Students **MUST** wear proper shoe attire that is approved by the instructor and/or school administrators.

No shorts, capris, short skirts, or baggy pants will be worn, as they are both a safety hazard in our labs as well as a distraction to learning. Additional dress code guidelines will be covered with your child during the first two weeks of school, but please note that no hate symbols (i.e. confederate flags, swastikas, etc.) and no gang symbols (including head gear such as bandanas and hats, etc.) will be tolerated.

I agree to the terms and conditions of the Warren County Career Center student dress code and will abide by the rules and regulations stipulated. I understand that the school will take disciplinary measures if this code is not followed.
