



2021 Uniform Details

As you prepare for your future with us here at WCCC, you will wear a uniform that is aligned with the industry field you're studying. The uniform is customized for the hands-on training you do each day. Wearing uniforms also protects your regular clothing, keep you looking professional, and helps staff identify students.

Each student should go online (directions below) to order uniforms as soon as possible. Be sure to follow directions and measure correctly for the best fit. **The cost for one uniform bundle is covered by student fees, so there is no charge from the site.** You are welcome to order additional items at your own expense.

ONLINE ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Once your measuring is complete (see the back of this sheet for measuring details), go to www.MyWCCC.org/WCCC2023.aspx
2. Click the uniform store button.
3. Select your program, select the required student pack and enter your clothing sizes. The pack will include all required uniform pieces for your program; any additional items are optional and not required.
4. Add the pack to the cart.
5. *Optional:* Continue shopping for optional pieces that you want to purchase in addition to the required student pack that is covered by fees.
6. When your ready to check out, go the the cart and select checkout to complete your order.

· **Order by June 20, 2021 to be eligible for exchanges and receive replacements before school starts.**

· **You MUST place your order before July 18, 2021 to receive FREE SHIPPING to the school for pickup in time for the beginning of school.** We will notify you via email of the dates and times you can pickup your items.


SIMPLE INSTRUCTIONS FOR DETERMINING CORRECT UNIFORM SIZES AT HOME

FITTING UNIFORMS AT HOME:

For the health and safety of our students, their families and our staff, we are not able to conduct in-person uniform fittings for the upcoming school year. As an alternative, we are asking that each student use the enclosed measuring tape to measure themselves for the proper uniform sizes.

MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS:

Please follow the instructions below to measure your student for their proper uniform size. A paper measuring tape has been provided to assist with measurements. Write down your measurements in the space below.




Men

CHEST Measure just under arms and across shoulder blades holding the tape firm and level. If your chest falls between sizes, order the next size up.

WAIST Measure around your natural waistline, keeping the tape comfortably loose.

INSEAM Measure pants that will fit you well. Lay them flat, with the front and back creased smooth. Measure along the inseam from crotch to bottom of leg hem. Or, if you don't have pants that fit comfortably, measure from your crotch to your desired pant length.



Women

BUST Measure the fullest part of your bust, keeping the tape level to the floor.

WAIST Measure around your natural waistline where your torso is the smallest.

HIPS Stand with feet together; position the measuring tape at the fullest part of your seat; bring tape to the front of your body keeping measuring tape parallel to the floor and level front to back.

INSEAM Measure pants that fit you well. Lay them flat, with the front and back creased smooth. Measure along the inseam from crotch to bottom of leg hem. Or, if you don't have pants that fit comfortably, measure from your crotch to your desired pant length.

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MEASURING TIPS:

- When measuring your waist move the tape measure as needed to continue measuring around your body until you reach the original starting point. Or use the tape to measure the waist of (non-elastic) pants that fit you well.
- Item-specific size charts are available on the website to help you determine the correct size for the individual uniform items you need to order. Compare your measurements above to these charts to determine the correct size.
- Men's pants are sized by waist and inseam measurements.
- Women's pants are sized using traditional women's sizing for the waist, but you will need to provide an inseam measurement to receive the correct length.
- Compare your measurements to your existing clothing. If you are in between sizes, consider choosing the larger size.
