The Adult Dental Assisting Program of the Warren County Career Center is designed to give adult learners relevant preparation to become successfully employed in Dental Assisting. Inherent in the program are opportunities for adult learners to emerge as skilled, productive individuals, trained in the latest technology, to meet the needs of industry.

Students are required to complete a 40 hour, unpaid externship in a local dental office as part of the 640 hour program. The externship is scheduled after all course work is completed.

Admission Requirements

- High School diploma or GED
- WorkKeys assessment
- Attend orientation meeting with program coordinator

Required Prior to Externship

- Pass FBI/BCI background check
- Required immunizations: Physical with TB (one-step) skin test, Hepatitis B Series

Certifications

- Ohio Certified Dental Assistant (CODA)
- Licensed Ohio Dental Radiographer
- Dental Assisting National Board Exam (DANB)*
- Health Care Provider CPR/First Aid
- WCCC Certificate of Program Completion
