Pharmacy Technicians assist pharmacists in preparing medication orders for patients. They also perform administrative duties such as answering phones, stocking shelves and ordering pharmacy items. Pharmacy technicians are required by the Ohio Board of Pharmacy to complete an approved training program. Through the nationally recognized Pharmacy Technician training program, students are given the skills and knowledge to qualify them for entry-level positions in pharmacies as well as prepare them for the national certification exam. Students will earn their CPhT (Certified Pharmacy Technician) certificate from PTCB (Pharmacy Technician Certification Board).

## Admission Requirements

- High School diploma or GED
- WorkKeys assessment

## Required Prior to Externship

- Pass FBI/BCI background check
- Required immunizations:  
Physical with 2-Step TB Test (not 1-Step TB),  
Hepatitis B Series, 2-MMR vaccines, flu vaccine,  
and Tetanus.

**Note:** A 200-hour externship is mandatory and will be scheduled throughout the program.
