



## Exposure or Positive Test of Student/Staff

**Staff and students must notify the school immediately if they have been exposed or diagnosed with COVID 19 and quarantine for 14 days:**

After known exposure, close contact, or a positive diagnosis, the individual (student/staff) must stay home. Virtual learning/teaching occurs if possible.

**Return to school dictated by Ohio Department of Health (ODH) and Warren County Health Department (WCHD) requirements.**

## District Communication of Positive Test of Student/Staff

**Initial communication of the positive test and/or exposure will come from the Warren County Health Department, not the school district.**

As a district we will cooperate with the Health Department's work in social tracing.

**A 14 day quarantine will be required of any student/staff who tests positive with COVID 19 and anyone who is determined to have "exposure" as determined by the Health Department.**

After the Health Department has completed contract tracing with the help of our district administration, **all affected individuals will be contacted by the Warren County Health Department, and notified of their need for isolation.**

**Once the Health Department has communicated with all involved, the district may then communicate (via our district website, email, and social media) that a positive case has occurred within district, and may provide details as to how many students and staff are involved (whether positive or exposed). As a district, we will not provide names or descriptive details about the person(s). While there may be public interest in the cases, our first priority will be the student and/or staff members right to privacy.** Any person that is determined to be at an exposure risk will have been notified by the WCHD; if you are a student and/or staff member, and you were not contacted, the WCHD has considered you not exposed.
