

Foreign Transcript Evaluation Process

WCCC does not have the resources or the expertise to evaluate academic transcripts for students who have attended academic institutions outside the United States. If you would like to have course work evaluated for the purpose of obtaining a high school equivalency test and/or college transfer credits, you must have your transcript evaluated by a foreign credentials evaluation service.

Once you receive the evaluation report from the service, you must send the report and an original certified copy of the transcript to the registrations office. **Warren County Adult Technical Center**
